Here is an excerpt of Baptisms at George Street Ind.Chapel  
Ryde of the Newnhams. Taken from Somerset House.  
(I have searched for marriages but none these records)

NEWNHAM Sarah bapt. July. 4. 1819, born Newchurch 5 June 1819--  
Emanuel Newnham of Ryde, labourer & Jane (father signs)  
Rev. Thos Guyer.

NEWNHAM JOSEPH bapt. 28. Nov. 1831 born 24. Nov. 1831. John Newnham a mason  
of Ryde signs and Frances Chandler  
Rev. Thos Guyer.

Newman Emma (really NEWNHAM), Dec. 25. 1831 born Oct. 1. 1831 Fredk Newman of  
Ryde, painter & Priscilla Woodrow, the mother signs.  
Thos Guyer. minister.

NEWNHAM William bapt. July. 21. 1833, born Apr. 7. 1833. Fredk NEWNHAM painter  
signs and Priscilla Woodrow. Thos Guyer minister.

Newman Frederic (Really NEWNHAM) bapt. 22 Feb. 1835, born Jany. 3. 1835  
Frederic Newman & Priscilla Woodrow of Ryde. both sign.

Newman Ellen Priscilla (really NEWNHAM) bapt. 5. Feb. 1837, born Dec. 20. 1836  
Frederick Newman painter & Priscilla Woodrow, both sign.

It plainly appears here that one does not know how to spell their  
own name, here's a man spelling it in two ways, so dont' forget to  
include all the NEWMANS you see when searching records. Directories  
too are bad examples of such spellings.

Here is a record of the 2nd marriage of Frances Chandler--  
Miller James Cook, bachelor, to Fanny Newnham, widow both of Portsm'  
by certificate at St Marys' Ch. Portsea Feb. 18. 1847.  
Witnesses-Mary Chandler & William Chandler, by H.T. May.

Kelly describes Wm Chandler as Smith & Carpenter, of Clypping in 1847  
Frances was born there.

Newnham Edward an ensign 9th foot. Feb. 14. 1805 was a prisoner of war  
in France 1805-13.

Newnham Abraham ensign 9th Norfolks Nov. 8. 1787 (Ex Army list)  
" " Wm 95th regt foot, alive 1851 to get Peninsula medal 6 bars.  
" " Peter 5th regt foot got same with 7 bars.

Newnham Mary dau' of Wm Rolfe & Mary Newnham " Oct. 5. 1775

NEWNHAM Nathaniel of St Benets, bachr. 23 to Honoria Kett of St Mary Axe 21  
consent of Thos Kett, St Mary Axe. Merchant. Jan. 27. 1695-6. spinster

NEWNHAM Lewis, St Mildred, bach. 24. & Thedoria Lemon about 17 dau' of Sir  
Wm Lemon (or Leman) Bart, Northall, Herts who consents.
